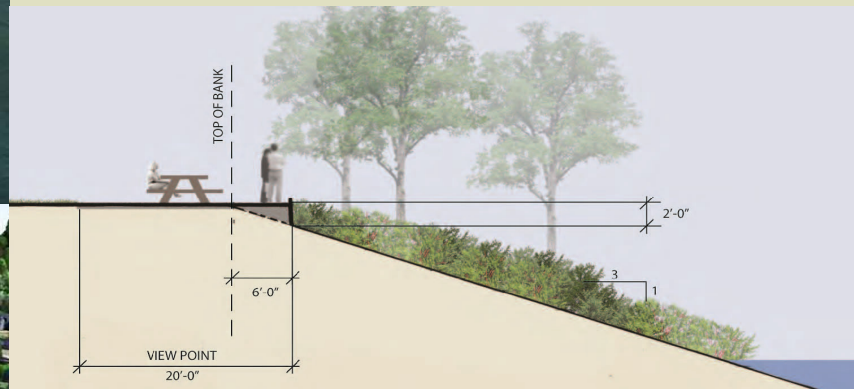

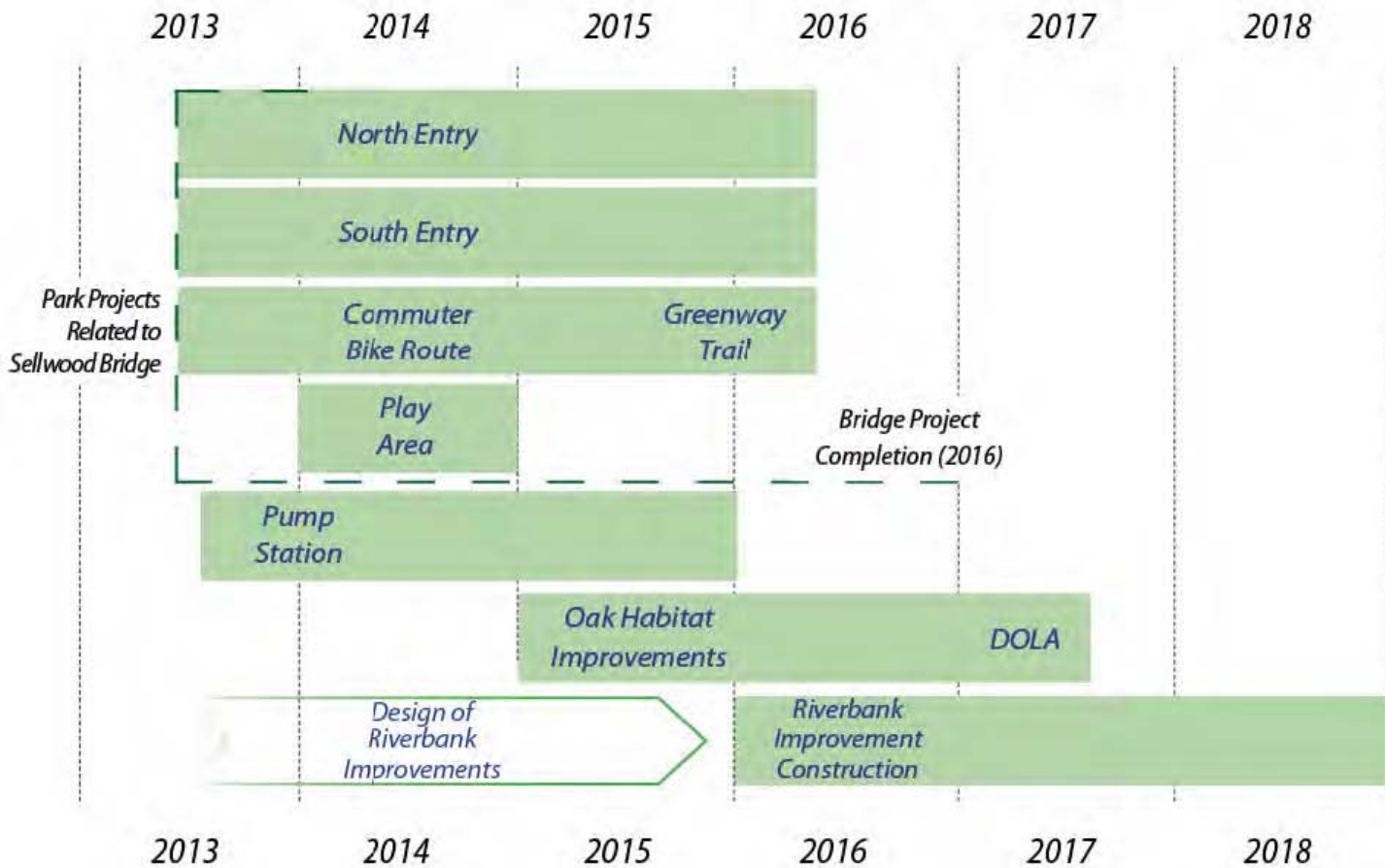

Funding Sources

Water Bureau - \$665,000 (\$50,000 used for planning)

BES – CIP request to fund the bank layback and associated Greenway improvements and recreation elements.
Contributed \$50,000 towards the planning effort
