ORDINANCE NO. 185880

Authorize the Chief of Police to execute Intergovernmental Agreements and amendments for Portland Police Data System and the successor Regional Justice Information Network in support of law enforcement information sharing (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Several municipalities currently utilize access to the Portland Police Data System (PPDS) and associated services through intergovernmental agreements.
- 2. The cost incurred by the Police Bureau for the additional PPDS services is offset by the revenue received for the services provided.
- 3. The City has embarked on a revitalization project to improve and replace PPDS with RegJIN.
- 4. Executing intergovernmental agreements and amendments in support of law enforcement information sharing networks would be most efficiently performed if delegated to the Chief of Police.
- 5. The effective dates of these amendments would be the date all parties have signed the contract, until termination.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Chief of Police may execute intergovernmental agreements and amendments related to law enforcement agencies' access to PPDS and the successor RegJIN.
