\*Authorize Asphaltic Concrete supply contracts for use on Maintenance Operations projects.  
(Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1: The Council finds:

1. Maintenance Operations performs routine road maintenance and paving work annually and has a need for Asphaltic Concrete (AC) materials to do this work.
2. In addition to the existing vendors currently under contract with the City, the Portland metro area has several other qualified and privately-owned AC suppliers that produce suitable, acceptable AC material for use on City projects,
3. Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) staff is working with Procurement Services to solicit bids from all qualified AC suppliers for the purpose of entering into new agreements that will replace those existing contracts that are about to expire.
4. Contracts between the City and AC supply vendors are necessary to allow the City to purchase materials on an as-needed / when-needed basis in order to perform any required maintenance and repair work.
5. Funds are available annually as part of Maintenance Operations Operating Fund to cover the costs of purchasing the AC materials.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to solicit for bids, and to negotiate and enter into supply contracts with any and all responsible and responsive vendors, provided the contracts have been approved as to form by the City Attorney's Office. The initial contract term for each vendor/supplier will be five years with extensions or renewals for up to an additional five years.
- b. The City Auditor to authorize and deliver warrants chargeable to Maintenance Operations Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.


Section 2: The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay will impact the City's ability to obtain AC materials needed to perform required maintenance work; therefore this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
