

ORDINANCE No. 185885

\* Amend contract with Northwest Testing, Inc. to increase contract amount by an additional \$33,205 to provide additional special testing and inspection services for the Emergency Coordination Center project. (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30002509)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. RFP No. FAC019 was issued October 25, 2011 for a contractor to provide special testing and inspection services for the Emergency Coordination Center project. A selection committee reviewed the responses and recommended award of the contract to Northwest Testing, Inc. who was the highest scoring Respondent.
2. The Agreement amount was \$113,037 with an expiration date of December 31, 2013.
3. Additional special testing and inspection services for the Emergency Coordination Center project, as shown in Attachment 1, are necessary to allow for completion of the project and included the following: Quality assurance shop inspection of welding and a temporary guard shack.
4. The fee for the additional services listed above is \$33,204.89 and is included in the budget for the Emergency Coordination Center project.
5. The Office of Management and Finance/Facilities Services recommends that Contract No. 30002509 with Northwest Testing, Inc. be amended, Attachment 1, to increase the contract by \$33,204.89 to provide additional special testing and inspection services for the Emergency Coordination Center project for a total Contract amount of \$146,241.89.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. The Chief Procurement Officer and Auditor are hereby authorized to amend Contract No. 30002509 to increase the contract amount by \$33,204.89 for a total contract amount of \$146,241.89 for additional special testing and inspection services for the Emergency Coordination Center project.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the fiscal year 2012-2013 budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

SECTION 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid additional expenses and a delay in the completion of this project; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
