The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. RFP No. FAC019 was issued October 25, 2011 for a contractor to provide special testing and inspection services for the Emergency Coordination Center project. A selection committee reviewed the responses and recommended award of the contract to Northwest Testing, Inc. who was the highest scoring Respondent.
- 2. The Agreement amount was \$113,037 with an expiration date of December 31, 2013.
- 3. Additional special testing and inspection services for the Emergency Coordination Center project, as shown in Attachment 1, are necessary to allow for completion of the project and included the following: Quality assurance shop inspection of welding and a temporary guard shack.
- 4. The fee for the additional services listed above is \$33,204.89 and is included in the budget for the Emergency Coordination Center project.
- 5. The Office of Management and Finance/Facilities Services recommends that Contract No. 30002509 with Northwest Testing, Inc. be amended, Attachment 1, to increase the contract by \$33,204.89 to provide additional special testing and inspection services for the Emergency Coordination Center project for a total Contract amount of \$146,241.89.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer and Auditor are hereby authorized to amend Contract No. 30002509 to increase the contract amount by \$33,204.89 for a total contract amount of \$146,241.89 for additional special testing and inspection services for the Emergency Coordination Center project.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the fiscal year 2012-2013 budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

SECTION 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid additional expenses and a delay in the completion of this project; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
