

ORDINANCE No. 185891

*Accept and appropriate an Intergovernmental Grant Agreement with Metro to accept funding for the Green Development Resource Center for FY 2012-2013 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:

1. In 2000, the City created the Green Building Program to develop a City Green Building policy and provide technical assistance, resources and training to Portland's building industry and residents to help reduce waste, conserve water, improve energy efficiency and improve durability and performance of buildings.
2. Demand for information and resources related to green development in the Portland region has continued to grow, and the Green Development Resource Center represents a multi-jurisdictional resource administered by the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability (BPS) to provide services beyond the Portland area that accelerate the spread of green building practices, waste reduction and site restoration activities. The Center leverages the City's efforts to make green building practices standard throughout the Portland region.
3. Since passage of Ordinance No. 181252 on September 5, 2007, Metro has contributed funding to the region-wide Green Development Resource Center to provide information about green building and site development practices to residents and the building industry throughout the Portland metro region. For Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Metro has contributed \$85,000.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into intergovernmental grant agreements with Metro in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The FY 2012-2013 budget is hereby amended as follows:
 - GRANTS FUND
 - Fund 217
 - Business Area – PN
 - Bureau Program Expenses: 00
- c. The Office of Management and Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, or requests for reimbursements from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

- d. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by Metro for grant award number 931749 provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.




