ORDINANCE NO. 185895

*Authorize application to Metro Regional Travel Options for a grant up to the amount of \$700,000 for transportation demand management projects (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Metro is soliciting projects for grant funding under the Regional Travel Options grant program.
- 2. The program is funding projects that support a multi-modal transportation system through demand management policies, strategies and projects.
- 3. The Bureau of Transportation intends to apply for a grant aimed at increasing active transportation use among residents across the city through interventions aimed at increasing walking and bicycling rates in select populations.
- 4. There is a 10.27% match requirement for this federally funded grant opportunity. The source of match will be in-kind donations, sponsorship funding, and limited Traffic Safety Account funds.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to Metro for a grant in the amount of up to \$700,000.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the grant application is due on February 22, 2013. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
