I. RECOMMENDATION. Grant a franchise to Tata Communications (America) Inc. for ten years.

BACKGROUND. In 2002, the City Council granted a ten-year franchise to Tyco Networks (US) Inc. (Tyco) to construct, operate and maintain a telecommunications system in the City's streets. In 2005, VSNL Telecommunications (US), Inc. (VSNL) acquired Tyco and requested the City Council's consent to transfer Tyco's franchise to VSNL. Tata Communications (America) Inc. is the successor in interest to VSNL, and City staff negotiated a franchise with Tata Communications for a new tenyear term to allow the company to continue maintaining its telecommunications system within Portland. Pursuant to the formal City Charter franchising requirements, the ordinance was published in the Daily Journal of Commerce on September 28, 2012, and a notice published in the Oregonian on September 27, 2012. #### 7. BACKGROUND / ANALYSIS

#### 8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

The City will continue to receive annual franchise fees in the amount of 5% of gross revenues. This revenue is intended for the general fund and is not new revenue.
