During a review of various contractor assessments conducted from 2005 through 2007 on behalf of the former Sheltered Market Program, it was found that claims remained outstanding for work performed as requested. With a further forensic review conducted by the City of Portland Police Bureau, it was determined that a claim should be made for the outstanding funds in the amount of \$16,995.00.

A claim for \$16,995.00 was filed. In an effort to avoid protracted litigation and seek a speedy resolution of the dispute, Ms. Browning has agreed to settle with Procurement Services as shown on Exhibit 1 (Settlement and Release Agreement).
