In response to Battalion Chief J. Klum's request Time: 2:45 PM

Will you please immediately order Chief of Police Mike Reese and Fire Chief Eric Janssens to reactivate HazMat #7 Fire & Rescue Truck to work in cooperation & coordination when a property owner calls about meth cooks with byproducts in yard(s) for evidence. Each cook is to have byproducts of Dams, bleach, & aluminum in air.

Please refer to 3-Page Document Independent 1/11/11 Police Review Complaint regarding Sergeant Tashia Hager #22213 with Officer Kyle Hefley Badge #50837. Sgt. Hager incorrectly identified Case Report #08-03-93-94, rather than Case Report #11-03-93-94 to report meth fumes from lower vent(s) on sides of rental with East wind blowing fumes into my yard. This specific Chronic Nuisance Complaint was from 4503 NE 27th and 2707 NE Prescott. The 2 years of fumes killed my Service Dog Dylan.

Exception to Current Drug Ordinance concerning Drug Houses: If a person has a Service Animal (Counts as a person) HazMat #7 with its 100 Sensors is to be sent out. Meth cooks in middle of night when other neighbors sleep. So HazMat needs to have access to victim's yard for toxic exposure. Please call Process in honor of Dylan's Ordinance Exception if it needs # for Code Procedure.

Neighbors have typed of request for grant funding (one page) for toxic living/deceased Service/Ordinary pets in ambulance to OSH Vet School to study toxic exposure & cure.

Briefly summarize what happened (attach additional pages or documents if needed):

Jan 11, 2011 I called 823-3333 about vandalism; Officer Ring called back to send out Officer Kyle Hefley #50837 who witnessed what I felt was a skunk smell with burnt smoke coming from 4503 NE 27th; and what Officer Kyle identified as a strong marijuana smell, and I insisted it had to be forced with something. Officer Hefley saw how "Sasha" of 4503 NE 27th entrenched deep SUV tracks eating up my tree roots (8-10' long in my soil); and I showed Officer how Sasha's vehicle keeps eroding my South NE Prescott

curb. Officer Hefley told me he would file a vandalism report and to call 911 when he returned to dispatch to catch driver called "Sa-she" License Plate #835 DJK. Next day in AM I noticed 20-25' additional curb kicked off causing my soil to bleed into street down into the sewer.

My neighbor thinks they used a hammer, and I thought a chisel because no chips left. My neighbor told me to call back Officer Hefley about additional vandalism, who said he wanted me to call him for Case Report #. Local meth cooker had been at 4503 NE 27th the day before, with Black male standing on my property, looking at tire tracks and curb at that time intact.

I phoned East Precinct 3x with additional information about ^{chipping} nuisance complaint. Neighbor witnesses told me to do so.

On 1/14/2011 at 5:30 AM I called 911 as Officer Hefley ~~at 911~~ ^{BP} told me to do. Operator #1 (Miss Suh?) told me sure she knows who I am the person police visit but never make a report on. She told me she'd let me speak to Sgt. on duty. I told her I wanted to speak to her Supervisor for detain.ing me 20-40 minutes on 911 as Driver of "Sasha" of SUV #835 DJK with attached object unloaded garage at 4503 NE 27th

looking like 25-50 pink bags of drugs
into his SUV and sauntered off.

Please note, the meth cooks at
4503 NE 27th and 4512 NE 26th
and 2535/2533 NE Prescott produced
toxic fumes that killed my Service Dog,
Jan. 2, 2013. Dylan would whine at
the meth cooks as they blew the fumes
into our backyard. I called "911" #100111
Operations Manager Alexander who
said Sgt. ~~Taisha~~^{Sheela} Hager was present &
she wrote Case # 08-03-93-94 but
Alexander of "911" said #11-03-93-94 was
correct # about vandalism. I phoned
Hager 30x; the Police Department
even gave me her cell phone which
I called 3-4x. Sgt. Hager failed follow-up.

Because my Service Dog died from
these meth fumes, and I called
the police around 300x about when
fumes were burning in my backyard,
and Police failed to dispatch
Fire Department with sensors.

Renters Faith, Miguel, Angelo, Sa-shan,
Andrea, all tormented my Service Dog
with drugs and food. They would
ring my door bell at 2:30 AM regularly
and dump next to my garage for rats.

Commissioner Nicky Srish told me
to have my lawyer contact him, or him
Commissioner ~~Nicky~~^{BB}. The death of a
trained Service Dog is like the death of a human,
so I decided to file complaint independently.

For Educational purposes, Will Multnomah County or City of Portland please provide Multnomah County PETS with a grant / monies for Corvallis Oregon State University Veterinary Students' education on how to care for / cure animals exposed to meth products as particulates in air or product ingredients?

There are 1,000 meth labs in N-NE Portland according to Sgt. Kelly. Exposure is quite common, and dogs appear to have 3-5x metabolism faster than humans. Vets are unaccustomed with toxic exposure. For educational purposes, will somebody please write a grant to provide monies to help exposed Service Animals & other pets both living and deceased? Will you please call it Dylan's Law? Please provide local vets with cost of pet visit; plus transport of pets &/or pet samples to OSU Veterinary Clinic?

(88) Since 2011, I had to call 823-3333 300x+ regarding meth labs spraying toxins into my yard from four sides with no police response.

Dear Portland Mayor Charlie Hales and City Council; esp. Steve Novick:

For educational purposes, will Multnomah County or City of Portland please provide grant money for the study of and care for domestic animals exposed to crystal methamphetamine byproducts? Specifically, grant money shall be directed to the Oregon State University veterinary program to study crystal meth products as particulates in the air and the effect of these particulates on domestic pets. Are there federal monies to curb this epidemic? I have been told that Drano, bleach and aluminum are some of the byproducts in every meth cook.

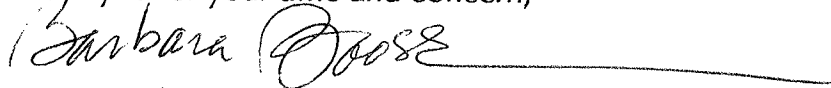
According to Sergeant Kelly, there are 1,000 methamphetamine labs in North and Northeast Portland. Exposure is quite common, and dogs appear to metabolize crystal meth particles many times faster than humans.

Will somebody please write a grant to provide funding to help exposed Service Animals and other domestic pets, both living and deceased? Will you please call it, "Dylan's Ordinance?" Veterinarians are unacquainted with toxic exposure, and little money has been designated to research toxic exposure in domestic pets. Dove Lewis provides no such program.

Please provide local veterinarians with funding to cover costs of veterinary visits and for transportation of sick or injured pets and / or pet remains to the Oregon State University veterinary clinic. 503-988-PETS used to but no longer provides free ambulance service to OSU.

Since 2011, I have called 823-3333 three hundred times regarding crystal meth labs spraying toxins into my yard from four sides. These toxins eventually killed my service dog Dylan. I have received no response from Portland Fire and Rescue when I have asked them to measure particulates in the air with sensors while a drug cook is in progress.

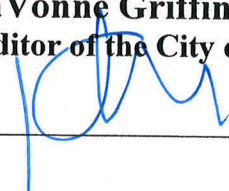
