- 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS: Ordinance Number 185867 passed by the Council on January 23, 2013 authorized a contract and provided payment for the construction of the Upper Hillsdale Sub-Basin RDII Pilot Project. In 2012 Council adopted Resolution 36977 recognizing the negative impact of Rainfall Derived Infiltration and Inflow (RDII) and endorsing implementation of RDII pilot projects. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for the first of the pilot projects to rehabilitate the deteriorated sewer pipes and service laterals from the sewer mainline to the house connection to mitigate RDII, and extending a portion of sewer to provide better service.
- 8. <u>FINANCIAL IMPACT:</u> The engineer's estimate for this project was \$2,350,000 and the confidence level was High. Funding for this project is available in the Sewer Operating Fund FY 12/13 Budget under WBS Element E10472.C60.
- 9. RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED: Accept Recommendation to award contract to Emery & Sons Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$2,157,955.
- 10. <u>SCOPE OF WORK ON PROJECT:</u> The project includes all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and supervision necessary to construct the Upper Hillsdale Sub-Basin RDII Pilot Project. This project involves rehabilitation of the existing sanitary sewer
