## ORDINANCE No. 185918

Authorize contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the NE 33<sup>rd</sup> Drive & Buffalo Slough Culvert Replacement Project, Phase 2 No. E10377 (Ordinance)

## The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Slough is water-quality limited with regards to several indicator pollutants, including temperature. The Bureau of Environmental Services has made a long-term commitment to improve the water quality of the Columbia Slough.
- 2. The existing culvert is positioned too high in the Slough to pass water easily during low flow conditions. This increases the water temperature upstream of the culvert, adding to the thermal pollutant load of the Slough. The Bureau of Environmental Services proposes to replace the existing culvert with a new, larger culvert that will pass larger flows and will eliminate the local bottleneck.
- 3. Environmental Services requires the furnishing of materials and labor for this project.
- 4. The estimated cost is \$1.7 million. The level of confidence in this estimate is "high." Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY13 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10377.C60, and the current and future years requested Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in charge is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the purpose described in Section 1 above.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
