

ORDINANCE No. 185931

Authorize contract and provide for payment for construction of the SW Huber Street Sidewalk Infill Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Transportation has identified critical gaps in the sidewalk network on arterial streets in Southwest Portland.
2. Bureau staff worked with Southwest Neighborhoods, Inc. to identify and select priority sidewalk projects to build with \$8 million for sidewalks on arterial streets in Southwest Portland.
3. SW Huber Street between SW Capitol Highway to SW 35th Avenue was identified as a priority sidewalk infill project.
4. The Bureau of Transportation has funds budgeted in FY 12/13 to construct, inspect and manage the project.
6. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate. The project is defined and plans and specifications are 60% complete.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor is authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to T00280.C42 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
