7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

This Ordinance settles a property damage claim by PGE against the City in the sum of \$7,269.79. The claim is the result of a sewage backup that occurred on June 6, 2012, which damaged PGE's gym space (the "Fit Factory") in the World Trade Center complex. The backup occurred due to the collapse of a section of sewer pipe in SW Jefferson Street, between SW 1st Avenue and SW Naito Parkway. Failure of the pipe caused sewage to back up into underground utility vaults in SW 1st Avenue, and leaked from the vaults into PGE's gym area.

PGE was in contact with City Risk Management soon after the event, and Risk has reviewed and verified the extent of damage and the costs for the clean-up.

8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of the settlement would result in a payment of \$7,269.79 from the liability fund.
