I. RECOMMENDATION. The Office for Community Technology recommends that Council approve this Ordinance amending the right-of-way use agreement granted to Cricket Communications, Inc.

II. BACKGROUND. On December 12, 2012, the Council approved a right-of-way use agreement to Cricket Communications, Inc. to build and operate wireless facilities within the City's streets. Ordinance No. 185788. The Ordinance renewed Cricket Communications' authority to occupy the City's right-of-way for an additional 3 year period and established terms and conditions for the use of the right-of-way. It is necessary to amend the Ordinance to provide clarification on the remittance date for the proper and effective administration of Cricket Communications' annual payment.
