

**RESOLUTION No. 37011**

Adopt the update to the Basic Emergency Operations Plan (Resolution)

WHEREAS, the highest priority of city government is to ensure a safe and peaceful community for all residents; and

WHEREAS, City bureaus have a shared responsibility to reduce the risk posed by earthquakes, floods and other natural and human caused hazards; and

WHEREAS, it is critical that essential services such as 9-1-1 dispatch and police and fire response continue without interruption; and

WHEREAS, the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management helps the City achieve these things by coordinating citywide emergency planning efforts and supporting the efforts of individual bureaus; and

WHEREAS, the primary citywide emergency planning document is the Basic Emergency Operations Plan (BEOP) which provides a framework for how Portland prepares for, reduces the risk of, responds to and recovers from emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the BEOP describes specific roles and responsibilities of City bureaus and how they will coordinate resources and activities with each other and our federal, state, county, regional, private-sector and non-governmental organization partners; and

WHEREAS, the BEOP profiles Portland's hazard vulnerabilities and the City's capabilities used to respond to those hazards, and outlines a multi-bureau concept of operations for the coordination of resources at different response levels to an emergency to ensure continuity of essential services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the update to the Basic Emergency Operations Plan is hereby adopted as a non-binding policy, substantially as set forth in Exhibit A, attached to this resolution.

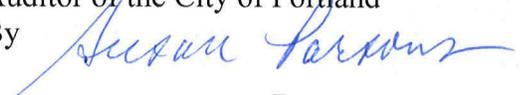

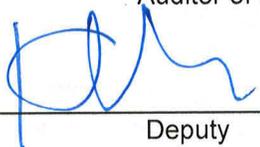
