Authorize City Attorney to appeal the judgment in *Gallagher Smith v. City of Portland*, Multnomah County Circuit Court No. 1110-13098 (Resolution).

WHEREAS, Gallagher Smith sued the City of Portland, alleging a number of claims arising out of his encounter with the police on the public sidewalk outside a downtown nightclub, and

WHEREAS, a critical issue in the case concerned whether the police had the authority to order Mr. Smith to leave the area of the public sidewalk outside the nightclub on the basis of information they had received that he was creating a disturbance when the proprietors of the nightclub denied him re-entry into the club, and

WHEREAS, the case was tried to a jury, and, notwithstanding PCC 14C.30.030, which authorizes Portland Police officers to direct pedestrian traffic on any public right of way, the Circuit Court instructed the jury that the police lacked probable cause to arrest Mr. Smith when he disobeyed their order to move away from the sidewalk in front of the nightclub, and

WHEREAS, the jury thereafter returned a verdict, and judgment was entered against the City of Portland on that verdict, for \$305,872.74, plus \$2,380.30 in costs, and

WHEREAS, Risk Management and the Portland Police Bureau desire that the City appeal the judgment in order to vindicate the authority of the police to maintain order, particularly in the downtown Entertainment District, and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney has advised that there is a legitimate basis for the appeal,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Attorney or his designee is authorized to file a notice of appeal of the judgment in *Gallagher Smith v. City of Portland*, Multnomah County Circuit Court No. 1110-13098.
