I. RECOMMENDATION. Grant a franchise to Integrated Regional Network Enterprise Telecommunications Services (IRNE) for ten years.

II. BACKGROUND. In 2000, the Portland City Council directed the Bureau of General Services Communications and Networking Division, now the Bureau of Technology Services, to implement IRNE. IRNE is a broadband telecommunications network for the City of Portland and its strategic IRNE partners and provides telecommunications services through fiber and other equipment in the City's rights of way. In 2003, the City Council granted a ten-year franchise to IRNE to construct, operate and maintain a telecommunications system in the City's streets. City staff negotiated a franchise with IRNE for a new ten-year term to allow it to continue maintaining its telecommunications system within Portland.

> Under the formal City Charter franchising requirements, the ordinance was published in the Daily Journal of Commerce on February 8, 2013, and a notice published in the Oregonian on February 5, 2013. The Bureau requests the first reading for this ordinance on March 13, 2013, and the second

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reading on April 17, 2013. Under this schedule the effective date will be on June 19, 2013.
