# 1) Legislation Title:

Grant a franchise to LightSpeed Networks Inc. for Telecommunications Services, for a period of 10 years. (Ordinance)

## 2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:

LightSpeed Networks is a CLEC who is seeking a franchise to construct a telecommunications system in Portland. The City of Portland and LightSpeed Networks have reached final agreement on a ten-year franchise, and the City approved a temporary revocable permit to LightSpeed Networks on January 23, 2013. Ordinance 185863. The temporary revocable permit was granted for a maximum of one year to allow the company to immediately begin construction of its telecommunications system in the public right-of-way pending the completion of the formal City Charter franchise procedure. Those procedures have now been met, and LightSpeed Networks requests the City formally grant it a franchise agreement for a ten-year term on substantially similar terms as granted to LightSpeed Networks under the temporary revocable permit.

Under the formal City Charter franchising requirements, the ordinance was published in the Daily Journal of Commerce on February 1, 2013, and a notice published in the Oregonian on February 1, 2013. The Bureau requests the first reading for this ordinance on March 13, 2013, and the second reading on April 17, 2013. Under this schedule the effective date will be on June 19, 2013.
