#### 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

Lisa Vasquez was hired to manage the PSSRP project in May of 2009 as an at-will employee. Her employment with the City was terminated in June of 2011. Ms. Vasquez alleges in a lawsuit pending in state court that she was retaliated against because she was a whistleblower and other claims. The City denies that Ms. Vasquez was a whistleblower or that she was treated unlawfully, but the parties entered into mediation which resulted in a tentative settlement to dispose of the case. The settlement requires City Council approval. In order to avoid the costs of extensive discovery and litigation involving many individuals who are no longer with the City, Risk Management and the City Attorney's office recommend that this case be settled for a total of \$87,500.00.

#### 8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of the settlement would result in a payment of \$77,500.00 from the liability fund and \$10,000.00 from the bureau payroll account.

### 9. RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED

Approve settlement of Lisa Vasquez claim in the sum of \$87,500.00 as an emergency ordinance on the consent agenda.
