ORDINANCE No. 186006

* Authorize a Memorandum of Understanding with Multnomah County, Volunteers of America, Oregon Home Free, Raphael House, Catholic Charities and the City of Portland Police Bureau for the purposes of the Department of Justice Office on Violence Against Women Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders program in order to continue operation of the Domestic Violence Enhanced Response Team (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Police Bureau has been an active member of the Multnomah County Family Violence Coordinating Council since 1999, with participating members active in the current version of the Domestic Violence Enhanced Response Team (DVERT) since its creation in 2006; and
- 2. The DVERT goals are to identify and effectively respond to high risk offenders and to increase the safety and well-being of victims; and
- 3. In 2012, partner agencies collaborated on the Department of Justice (DOJ) Office on Violence Against Women (OVAW) Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders (GTEAP) grant application; and
- 4. The 2012 DOJ OVAW GTEAP grant was awarded to Multnomah County in late 2012. The grant period is January 1, 2013, through September 30, 2014; and
- 5. The Memorandum of Understanding establishes a set of aspirations and goals among the partners. It is not legally enforceable and shall not be construed to create any legal obligation on the part of any party. It shall not be construed to create a private right, benefit, or cause of action for or by any person enforceable at law or equity against any partner, their officers, employees, or any other person.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement a. substantially in accordance with the attached Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would deprive the partner agencies of the benefits of the agreement. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
