7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

April 16 2013

This Ordinance settles a sewer backup claim by GSL Properties, Inc., through National Subrogation Services. The damage occurred at the claimant's commercial building located at 2164 SW Park Place in September 2010. The verified amount of property damage was \$25,052.30. The claimant's property insurer paid the repair costs, and then brought a subrogation claim against the City. This settlement resolves that claim for 50% of the verified damages.

The backup at this location occurred in a clay pipe sewer segment that was initially installed in 1889. The cause of the backup was a combination of heavy rains and a root blockage in the connection between the lateral and the main. Following the backup, City crews dug up and replaced the lateral and part of the main.

8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of the settlement would result in a payment of \$12,526.15 from the liability fund.

Approve settlement of GSL Properties, Inc. property damage claim in the sum of \$12,526.15.
