* Ratify a Letter of Agreement between the City on behalf of the Portland Water Bureau and the AFSCME, Local 189-1 authorizing an alternative work schedule for employees in the Water Treatment Operator classification who work at Headworks (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The City and the District Council of Trade Unions (DCTU), of which AFSCME, Local 189-1 is a member, are parties to a collective bargaining agreement (CBA) effective July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2013.
- 2. AFSCME, Local 189-1 is the sole bargaining representative on behalf of employees working at the Portland Water Bureau (PWB) in the Water Treatment Operator classification.
- The City and AFSCME, Local 189-1 have entered into a new Letter of Agreement (LOA) that replaces the LOA on p. 148 of the CBA.
- The new LOA authorizes an alternative schedule that provides 24/7 coverage, offers flexibility, is cost efficient, and increases employee satisfaction.
- The Bureau will fund this LOA within its current service level budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

The LOA between the City and AFSCME, Local 189-1 attached as Exhibit A is hereby ratified by the Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order that this compensation action may occur without delay; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
