## ORDINANCE No. 186024

\* Ratify a grievance settlement agreement between the City on behalf of the Portland Water Bureau and the AFSCME, Local 189-1 authorizing shift differential pay for employees in the Water Treatment Operator classification who work the Day 1 and Day 2 schedule (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City and the District Council of Trade Unions (DCTU), of which AFSCME, Local 189-1 is a member, are parties to a collective bargaining agreement (CBA) effective July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2013.
- 2. AFSCME, Local 189-1 is the sole bargaining representative on behalf of employees working at the Portland Water Bureau (PWB) in the Water Treatment Operator classification.
- 3. On January 6, 2011, AFSCME, Local 189-1 filed a grievance alleging that the City stopped the practice of paying Water Treatment Operators assigned to the Day 1 and Day 2 schedule four (4) hours of shift differential pay for hours worked between 4:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.
- 4. The City and AFSCME, Local 189-1 has entered into a settlement agreement to resolve this grievance.
- 5. The parties agree that the City will pay Water Treatment Operators assigned to the Day 1 and Day 2 schedule four (4) hours of shift differential pay for hours worked between 4:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. retroactive to June 11, 2009.
- 6. The Bureau will fund the settlement agreement within its current service level budget.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The grievance settlement agreement between the City and AFSCME, Local 189-1 attached as Exhibit A is hereby ratified by the Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order that this compensation action may occur without delay; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
