ORDINANCE No. 186035

* Amend contract with Michael Willis Architects to increase contract amount by an \$82,655 to provide additional architectural and engineering services for new construction of the Emergency Coordination Center. (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30000701)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. A Request for Proposals for architectural and engineering services for new construction of the Emergency Coordination Center was issued on April 22, 2009. Six proposals were received on May 21, 2009. A selection committee reviewed the proposals and recommended award of contract to Michael Willis Architects as they were the highest scoring proposer.
- 2. Contract No. 30000701 provides for architectural and engineering services in the amount of \$957,819 to design a new Emergency Coordination Center facility directly adjacent to the existing Portland Communications Center located in southeast Portland. There are three main components of this project: a new Emergency Coordination Center building, new parking lot, and realignment of a section of SE Bush Street. Expiration date of Contract No. 30000701 was June 1, 2012.
- 3. The new building will serve as the City's Emergency Coordination Center and house the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM), Portland Water Bureau (PWB) Emergency Management and Security staff.
- 4. Amendment No. 1 issued March 2011, increased the contract amount \$166,251.25 to allow for additional architectural and engineering services.
- 5. Amendment No. 2 (ordinance no. 185252), dated May 2, 2012, increased the contract amount \$86,767.66 and extended the expiration date to January 1, 2014 to allow for additional architectural and engineering services.
- 6. Amendment No. 3, dated April 2013, increased the contract amount \$40,680 to allow for additional architectural and engineering services.
- 7. This amendment increases the Contract amount by \$82,655 to allow for additional architectural and engineering services described in the attached Exhibit A. The cost of the amendment is included in the FY 2012-13 budget.
- 8. The Office of Management and Finance/Facilities Services recommends that Contract No. 30000701 with Michael Willis Architects for architectural and engineering services for the Emergency Coordination Center new construction project be amended, Exhibit A attached, to increase amount by \$82,655 for a new total Contract value not to exceed \$1,344,172.91.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor and Chief Procurement Officer are hereby authorized to amend Contract No. 30000701 with Michael Willis Architects, Exhibit A attached, and increase amount by \$82,655 for a new total Contract amount of \$1,344,172.91.

b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the fiscal year 2012-2013 budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

SECTION 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid additional expenses and a delay in the completion of this project; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
