- 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS: Ordinance Number 185741 passed by the Council on November 28, 2012 authorized a contract and provided payment for the construction of the SW Spring Garden Sidewalk Infill Project. The purpose of this project is to construct street, sidewalk and drainage improvements along SW Spring Garden Street. Bureau Staff worked with Southwest Neighborhoods, Inc. to identify and select priority sidewalk projects on arterial streets in Southwest Portland.
- **8. FINANCIAL IMPACT:** The engineer's estimate for this project was \$725,000.00 and the confidence level was Moderate. Funding for this project is available in FY 12/13 Budget under WBS Element T00320.C42.
- 9. <u>RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED:</u> Accept Recommendation to award contract to Brown Contracting, Inc. in the amount of \$728,830.00.
