ORDINANCE NO. 186046

* Authorize a grant agreement with Portland Opportunities Industrialization Center, Inc. in the amount of \$54,387 to provide a Gang Impacted Family Team Coordinator to provide an aligned system of support for program stakeholders serving gang impacted youth and families (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In February 2012, the Gang Impacted Family Team (GIFT) program was formed as a non-funded collaborative City, County and State services multi-disciplinary team. The team was created to provide support for youth and families to break intergenerational ties that perpetuate gang involvement and violence within the community.
- 2. The GIFT program continues to be a non-funded multiple agencies service and is in need of full time coordinator who will ensure that all involved agencies and personnel are aligned in process to adequately assist GIFT clients in an expedient manner.
- 3. In March 2013, the City Council approved Ordinance #185927 allowing the Mayor's Office of Youth Violence Prevention to apply to the State of Oregon, Youth Development Council for grant funding to provide a GIFT Coordinator position.
- 4. In May 2013, the City Council approved Ordinance #186010 allowing the City through the Mayor's Office of Youth Violence Prevention to accept a grant award amount of \$47,188.80 from the State of Oregon, Youth Development Council.
- 5. Local matching funds provided by funds from the FY 2012-13 Mayor's Office, Office of Youth Violence Prevention Budget will be used to fulfill the remaining balance of the grant.
- 6. Portland Opportunities Industrialization Center (POIC), a local 501C3, was chosen to provide the GIFT Coordinator Position based upon having specialized services available to gang impacted youth and families while working collaboratively with GIFT stakeholder services.
- 7. The amount of this grant is not to exceed \$54,387.00.
- 8. The grant agreement will be for a period of 1 year, from June 1, 2013 through May 31, 2014.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

a. The City of Portland designates and authorizes the funding contained in this ordinance to be a grant. The Office of the Mayor is authorized, on behalf of the City, to enter into a Grant Agreement with Portland Opportunities Industrialization Center Inc. as substantially set forth in Exhibit A attached to this ordinance.

- b. The funds will come from the Office of Youth Violence Prevention funds currently administered by the Office of Mayor Charlie Hales.
- c. The Mayor and Auditor are authorized to draw and deliver checks to the Portland Opportunities Industrialization Center Inc., chargeable to the FY 2012-2013 General Fund Budget.
- d. The Grant Manager is authorized to renew this grant in the same or different amount, provided that sufficient funds are appropriated by City Council and included within the City's approved budget for fiscal year 2014-2015.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the date for service to commence under the grant agreement will June 1, 2013. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
