## **ORDINANCE** No. 186047

\*Authorize the Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services or designee and the City Attorney to enter into a settlement agreement with Kathleen Benafel. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

- Section 1. The Council finds:
  - 1. On September 12, 2012 the Washington County Hearings Officer issued a conditional approval for the construction of the SW 86th Avenue Pump Station and Appurtenances ("the Project"), Washington County file no. 12-174-SU/D/FP.
  - 2. One condition of the approval was that the City must "determine what additional measures are feasible to implement in order to reduce . . . impacts" to "any household [with] particular sensitivities to construction . . . ."
  - 3. Ms. Kathleen Benafel lives at 7060 SW 84th Avenue, adjacent to the Project, and has represented to the City that she or a member of her family suffers from particular sensitivities to construction such as that required by the Project. Ms. Benafel has concluded that retrofitting her home is her only choice in the face of the estimated two years and nine months of construction.
  - 4. The Bureau of Environmental Services ("BES") has concluded that it would be feasible and reasonable to pay a portion of Ms. Benafel's retrofitting costs.
  - 5. BES proposes to pay Ms. Benafel up to \$51,000 upon the provision to BES of the invoices for these services.
  - 6. Ms. Benafel will agree that this payment will fully discharge the City's obligations to her under the above-quoted condition of approval and that she will forever waive any claims against the City in relation to the potential impacts of the Project.
  - 7. The established not-to-exceed cost is \$51,000. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2013 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Project Number E09051.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services or designee and the City Attorney are authorized to enter into a settlement agreement with Kathleen Benafel in substantial conformance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2013 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Project Number E09051. when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2.

The Council declares that an emergency exists because Ms. Benafel's home needs to be modified prior to construction of the pump station. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


