BACKGROUND. In 1998, the City Council granted a ten-year franchise to 360networks (USA) inc. fka Pacific Fiber Link (360networks) to construct, operate and maintain a telecommunications system in the City's streets. In 2000, the City Council granted a ten-year franchise to Metromedia Fiber Network Services Inc. dba Abovenet Inc. (Abovenet) to construct, operate and maintain a telecommunications system in the City's streets. Zayo Group acquired 360networks in December 2011 and Abovenet in July 2012. Zayo owns and operates the telecommunications systems originally constructed by 360networks and Abovenet and will be solely responsible for performance and compliance of these systems. This ordinance combines Zayo's franchise responsibilities and authorities under one agreement for a new term. Under the formal City Charter franchising requirements, the ordinance was published in the Daily Journal of Commerce on February 8, 2013, and a notice published in the Oregonian on March 25, 2013. The Bureau requests the first reading for this ordinance on April 24, 2013 and the second reading on May 29, 2013. Under this schedule the effective date will be on July 29, 2013.

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To help ensure equal access to programs, services and activities, the Office of Management & Finance will reasonably modify policies/procedures and provide auxiliary aids/services to persons with disabilities upon request.
