### 1. Background

Parks and BES want to manage, pursuant to a conservation easement, an approximately .66 acre portion of a property adjacent to Deardorff Creek Natural Area since it has a tributary to the creek and other resource value. The property also contains a house that will be retained by the owner.

### 2. **Financial Impact**

The price of the conservation easement will be the fair market value as determined by an appraiser. We have not yet received the appraisal. The purchase price and related costs will be paid from BES Grey to Green funds and Parks Local Share of the 2006 Metro Open Spaces Bond. O&M costs are estimated at \$1225/year which will be requested by Parks as part of the budget process.

Pursuant to authority granted to BES and Parks in Ordinances 181710 and 183819, Parks and BES have authority to purchase property interests using Grey to Green and Local Share funds. Typically, this transaction would be completed following the processes described in those

ordinances. Under state law, however, a public hearing is required when certain government agencies acquire conservation easements, so we are seeking Council approval to meet that requirement.
