ORDINANCE No. 186083

Increase time period for property owners to repair sidewalks, curbs and driveways to 60 days (Ordinance; amend Code Sections 17.28.080, 17.28.090 and 17.28.110)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The time period of 20 days allowed for property owners to complete the repair of hazards identified on a Sidewalk Repair notice is not a realistic and/or adequate period of time.
- 2. This proposal will allow additional time needed to complete the required repairs; receive the notice, contact and schedule a meeting if necessary with the Inspector to understand what is required to remove the hazard(s), get bids from contractors, and secure finances for repair.
- 3. This proposal will change code language from existing 20 days to proposed 60 calendar days to complete repairs for all posted hazards.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

Amend Portland City Code Sections 17.28.080, 17.28.090, and 17.28.110 as a. indicated in Exhibit A.
