



PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Portland referred to the voters of the City at the Municipal non-partisan Special Election held on May 21, 2013, a measure with the ballot title “Renew Five Year Levy to Prevent Child Abuse, Child Hunger,” and such measure was designated on the ballot as Measure 26-150, and according to the official canvas 119,026 votes were cast in favor of said measure, and 40,115 were cast against said measure, now, therefore, it is hereby
