

## ORDINANCE No. 186114

\*Amend contract with Immigrant and Refugee Community Organization for street-level gang outreach for FY 2013-14 (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 32000477)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1: The Council finds:

1. Since 2008 violence related to gang activity has continued to increase in the City of Portland, and it has become necessary to direct funds to provide street-level gang outreach services in the city.
2. The City of Portland recognizes the need to address youth violence problems in a way that respects all members of the community, empowers the community to solve problems with assistance from the police if needed and uses comprehensive, best-practice solutions.
3. Street-level gang outreach is considered a best-practice in suppressing gang violence which requires identifying and intervening in the cycle of street-level violence between high-risk gang members and their associates, and working in areas of the city considered hotspots for gang-activity while coordinating with law enforcement and other service providers.
4. In February of 2009, the City of Portland's Office of Youth Violence Prevention (OYVP) created a Request for Grant (RFG) seeking proposals from grantees with experience in providing street-level gang outreach service to high-risk gang-involved and gang-associated youth and young adults up to the age of 25 for the months of May through August of 2009. The Immigrant and Refugee Community Organization was selected to receive grant funding for street level outreach services under the funding and terms of the RFG.
5. Immigrant and Refugee Community Organization employees have performed Street Level Gang Outreach services from May 2009 through June 2013.
6. During the course of the previous grant period the Immigrant and Refugee Community Organization, in collaborative efforts with the Portland Police Bureau, Multnomah County Department of Community Justice, Oregon Youth Authority and OYVP, supplied street-level outreach and intervention to at risk and gang affected youth and received excellent reviews from all the above government agency partners.
7. Due to the success in fulfilling the scope of work assigned under Grant Agreement No. 32000477 for Street-Level Gang Outreach services from September 2010 through June 2013, the uniqueness and efficiency of their service delivery, and the benefit derived by the City through the application of their services during the previous grant periods, the basis for this Grant Agreement for street-level gang outreach services has been established.
8. This ordinance authorizes the Mayor, or the Mayor's designee, to renew this grant on July 1, 2013 in the same or different amount provided that sufficient funds are appropriated by City Council and included within the City's adopted budget for fiscal year 2013-14. In addition, this ordinance authorizes the Mayor, or Grant Manager, to execute an amendment to renew this grant agreement, subsequent to fiscal year 2013-14, in the same or different amount provided that sufficient funds are appropriated by City Council and included within the City's budget.

9. Council has appropriated the Youth Violence Prevention funds associated with this grant agreement amendment. These Youth Violence Prevention funds are currently included in the FY 2013-14 adopted budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The City of Portland designates and authorizes the expenditure of funds authorized by this ordinance to be a grant. The Mayor, or the Mayor's designee, is authorized, on behalf of the City, to execute an amendment that renews Grant Agreement No. 32000477 in the same or different amount provided that sufficient funds are appropriated by City Council and included within the City's adopted budget for fiscal year 2013-14.
- b. The funds associated with this grant agreement amendment will come from the Office of Youth Violence Prevention funds. This program reports to the Office of Mayor Charlie Hales. Funds are administered through City Special Appropriations.
- c. The Mayor, or the Mayor's designee, is authorized to renew Grant Agreement No. 32000477 in the same or different amount subsequent to fiscal year 2013-14 provided that sufficient funds are appropriated by City Council and included within the City's budget.


Section 2: The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay will jeopardize the timely execution of this Grant Agreement Amendment which may impact the Immigrant and Refugee Community Organization's ability to deliver services required under this Grant; therefore, this Ordinance is in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.


