

# ORDINANCE No. 186148

\*Approve an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland State University for the Hatfield Resident Fellows Program for training and leadership development for candidates interested in the public sector (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Center for Public Service and the Mark O. Hatfield School of Government at Portland State University (PSU) host several highly competitive fellowships that are designed to bring national class talent to Oregon public enterprises.
2. The Hatfield Resident Fellows program is Fellowship designed to provide training and leadership development opportunities for candidates interested in the public sector. The program is designed to build public sector capacity in Oregon by increasing the number of leaders who are devoted to public service.
3. Each Hatfield Fellow serves an eight-month stint in the public sector, working on new or unique project-specific activities. The cost is \$35,000, and there is no commitment to the fellow beyond the eight months.
4. The City Budget Office has identified a promising Hatfield Resident Fellow to work on a number of projects of citywide significance over the next eight months.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement between the City and Portland State University, in substantially the same form as Exhibit A, to allow the City Budget Office to bring on a Hatfield Resident Fellow.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants payable to Portland State University, not to exceed \$35,000, chargeable to the City Budget Office.



The Council declares that an emergency exists because it is necessary to get final approval to bring on a Hatfield Fellow in order to ensure that the City is able to recruit the fellow most suited to the City's project needs; therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage.
