ORDINANCE No. 186150

\*Authorize a competitive bidding process for an Auctioneering contract for CityFleet to dispose of obsolete vehicles and equipment valued at \$1,000,000 per year (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The CityFleet Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Services disposes of obsolete vehicles and equipment, in accordance with city code and charter 5.36.010.
2. CityFleet is responsible for managing the disposal of City vehicles and equipment for the City of Portland.
3. The previous Auctioneering contract expired and there is a need to replace this contract with a new Auctioneering contract.
4. The estimated sales through the Auctioneering contract are estimated to be about \$1,000,000 per year.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to use a competitive solicitation process as permitted under City Code 5.33 for a new Auctioneering contract.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with the purchases may result in additional expense. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
