

ORDINANCE No. 186151

* Accept two federal grants totaling \$552,018 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the administration of the regional Homeless Management Information System and OTIS supportive housing programs (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

1. The Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) applied to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for two grants totaling \$552,018 for the administration of the regional Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) and OTIS supportive housing programs on January 17, 2013; and
2. HUD has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the administration of the regional Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) to PHB in the amount of \$245,666 and a grant for the OTIS supportive housing program in the amount of \$306,352.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:


- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland grants from HUD for the administration of the regional Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) and OTIS supportive housing programs in the total amount of \$552,018 and to execute intergovernmental agreements in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibits A and B.
- b. PHB and the Office of Management and Finance Grants Office are authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- c. The Director of PHB of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by HUD for HMIS grant and the OTIS project grant, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
