I. RECOMMENDATION. Grant a franchise to Kinder Morgan Cochin for twenty years.

II. BACKGROUND. Kinder Morgan Cochin LLC, the successor in interest to Chevron Pipeline Company, has requested the City grant it a franchise for a renewed term. Kinder Morgan Cochin and the City reached final agreement on terms and conditions of a 20 year franchise for Kinder Morgan Cochin to use the City Streets to own and operate a Pipeline System. Pursuant to the formal City Charter franchising requirements, the ordinance was published in the Daily Journal of Commerce on April 10, 2013, and a notice published in the Oregonian on April 22, 2013.
