

# ORDINANCE No. 186167

Authorize the Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services to execute Intergovernmental Agreements for the continued implementation of the Innovative Wet Weather Program, not to exceed in aggregate \$300,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) uses green streets, ecoroofs, trees and other forms of green infrastructure to increase sewer system efficiency and protect water quality, public health and the environment.
2. Green infrastructure keeps stormwater out of the sewer system, filters pollutants, provides habitat and increases neighborhood green space for healthier watersheds.
3. Between 2002 and 2009 BES obtained several appropriations totaling \$3.4 million from Congress through a grant from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The EPA grant funds innovative stormwater projects through the Innovative Wet Weather Program (IWWP). In May 2012, the grant agreement with the EPA was amended to approve budget revisions and extend the grant budget period to December 31, 2014 (Ordinance 185362).
4. Over 30 public and private projects have been chosen by EPA and BES to showcase innovative stormwater approaches.
5. Up to four individual agreements between the City and other government agencies are necessary to help fund project implementation.
6. The established cost is \$300,000. Costs shall be reimbursed by EPA Innovative Wet Weather Program Grant (XP97045801) under the Grants Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services is authorized to execute Intergovernmental Agreements for the purpose described in Section 1, in forms similar to Exhibit A attached herein, not to exceed in aggregate \$300,000.
- b. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services is authorized to execute amendments to these agreements.


