

ORDINANCE No. 186188

\* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County to reimburse Police Bureau overtime costs up to \$15,000 for education and enforcement efforts to reduce alcohol service to visibly intoxicated persons and service to minors at Portland bars and nightclubs (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Strategic Prevention Framework State Incentive Grant provides funding to the Multnomah County Department of County Human Services Mental Health and Addiction Services Division to support efforts to reduce service to visibly intoxicated persons (VIPs) and service to minors at Portland bars and nightclubs through education and increased enforcement.
2. The Police Bureau has agreed to provide education sessions to the staffs of no fewer than 15 bars or nightclubs as well as commit plain-clothes officer time to enforce service to VIPs violations for no fewer than 20 nights over the term of the agreement.
3. The agreement would be in effect from July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014.
4. The maximum payment under this agreement shall not exceed \$15,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with Multnomah County in a form similar to the Intergovernmental Agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The City Attorney shall review and approve as to form any amendment to this agreement with Multnomah County before it is authorized by the Chief of Police.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this agreement will unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of this agreement. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.



