ORDINANCE No. 186194

*Amend a price agreement with Feeney Wireless, LLC, to add \$1,500,000 for additional purchases of Mobile Data Computer replacement laptops for the Portland Police Bureau and to extend the term by six months (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 41251)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On September 3, 2008, City Council passed Ordinance No. 182151, authorizing a price agreement for Mobile Data Computer (MDC) replacement laptops for the Portland Police Bureau.
- 2. A formal competitive Invitation to Bid was conducted in accordance with PCC 5.33 and Feeney Wireless, LLC was determined to be the lowest responsible bidder. Price Agreement No. 41251 was executed by the City of Portland and Feeney Wireless, LLC, effective September 17, 2008, to provide MDCs and related equipment and services.
- 3. The current CF-19 MDCs need to be replaced as they are at the end of their useful life and are no longer adequate to run standard Police Bureau applications. These MDCs need to be replaced because support for the Windows XP platform will no longer be available as of April 2014. This will cause network security vulnerability for police operations and investigations.
- 4. The Police Bureau and Bureau of Technology Services have determined the new system should be modified by requiring larger in-car computer monitors, thereby decreasing the vibration currently experienced with the in-car computer monitors. This new solution will include enhanced mobile technology that is an integral part of the officer patrol function including better global positioning technology (GPS) and integration with Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD), automated license plate recognition software, mobile audio/video recording, a more robust mobile records management system, court scheduling, mobile report writing, and electronic citations application. This new solution will also ensure officer safety by increasing sight line visibility within the new Chevrolet Caprice patrol cars.
- 5. After a rigorous product review process the solution determined to best meet the Police Bureau's requirements was the Panasonic product as provided by the existing contractor, Feeney Wireless, Inc.
- 6. Feeney Wireless is an Oregon distributor and has been a very reliable supplier with a history of excellent service to the City. Feeney has fostered a direct link between the Police Bureau and the manufacturer and has provided important support when technical issues have arisen. These efforts have resulted in a decrease in technical down time and have provided Police Bureau subject matter experts, BTS management and support staff valuable technical knowledge.

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- 7. This Ordinance authorizes an extension to Price Agreement No. 41251 with Feeney Wireless for an additional six months through March 31, 2014, in order to acquire new MDCs for approximately 326 cars by adding \$1,500,000.00 to the Price Agreement's value, resulting in a new not-to-exceed value of \$2,734,085.00.
- 8. Funding from the City's replacement fund is available and has been approved for use with this project. To help absorb the costs associated with this project, as part of the 2008 MDC replacement project, a five year life cycle replacement (LCR) funding account was set up with funds being collected since July 2009.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

The Chief Procurement Officer is hereby authorized to execute an amendment to Price a. Agreement No. 41251 with Feeney Wireless LLC for an additional \$1,500,000.00 in a form similar to the contract amendment attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists as the City must have all MDCs configured and installed by April 2014 in order to meet the end of support deadline for Windows XP. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


