## ORDINANCE No. 186198

\*Authorize application to the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for a grant in the amount of \$279,486 for the implementation of state and local homeland security strategies. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council Finds:

- 1. The State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP) supports the implementation of state and local homeland security strategies to address the identified planning, organization, equipment, training, and exercise needs to prepare for, respond to and recover from natural or man-made disasters.
- 2. The Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) has applied to the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for an SHSGP FY 2013 grant in the amount of \$279,486.
- 3. These funds will be used (1) as bridge funding to sustain the Portland Urban Area's (PUA) regional emergency preparedness collaboration and planning efforts through the Regional Disaster Preparedness Organization (RDPO), including funding for three staff positions for seven months; (2) to support continuation of Portland's instance of the WebEOC incident management system (software license and maintenance renewals), and travel costs and attendance of four WebEOC administrators throughout the PUA to the 2014 WebEOC annual conference; (3) to support continuation of Multnomah County's community emergency notification system; and (4) to support the training and equipment needs of Portland's Community Emergency Response Team/Neighborhood Emergency Team (NET) program (basic NET trainings, including one in Spanish, an advanced NET training, and helmets for NET volunteers).
- 4. City Code requires that grant applications be approved by ordinance prior to submission. Due to the short timeline for submission of the application, an ordinance was not filed. PBEM is submitting to Council for retroactive approval of the application by ordinance.

5. No match is required by this Grant

NOW THEREFORE, the Council Directs:

- a. The Mayor and Portland Bureau of Emergency Management are authorized to apply for the grant from the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management in the amount of \$279,486.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the

## grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in that any delay in the application for this grant will result in losing the opportunity for funding these activities; therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
