## ORDINANCE No. 186202

\*Accept a grant from Safe Routes to School Program for \$498,000 and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Department of Transportation for design engineering and construction of bicycle and pedestrian safety improvements at four Portland public elementary schools. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On July 25, 2007, Council passed Ordinance No. 181167 that authorized the Portland Bureau of Transportation to submit two applicants to receive grant funding through Safer Routes to School Program, administered by the Oregon Department of Transportation.
- 2. On October 12, 2012, the Oregon Department of Transportation awarded the Portland Bureau of Transportation a Safer Routes to School grant to fund bicycle and pedestrian safety improvements at four Portland public elementary schools.
- 3. The grant covers the total anticipated cost for engineering and construction of the project, estimated at approximately \$498,000.
- 4. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is low, because the project has not yet been engineered.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the Safer Routes to School in the amount of \$498,000 and to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement, in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. PBOT will match the ODOT grant at 10.27%. The project is budgeted in the FY 13/14 Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
