

ORDINANCE No. 186212

* Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Judicial Department for the care and handling of video conferencing equipment owned by the City but physically maintained at the Multnomah County Courthouse in downtown Portland (Ordinance; amend Ordinance No. 184591)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. In March 2010 the City of Portland accepted a grant in the amount of \$25,000 from the Mt. Hood Cable Regulatory Commission to support the purchase of video conferencing equipment for use during restraining order ex parte appearances at the Gateway Center for Domestic Violence Services.
2. The City purchased and installed the video conferencing equipment at the Gateway Center and in the Multnomah County Courthouse at 1021 SW 4th Avenue in Portland, Oregon.
3. The City retains ownership of the equipment.
4. The Oregon Judicial Department provides technical support and maintenance for the equipment located in the courthouse.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is hereby authorized to enter into an amendment to an agreement with the Oregon Judicial Department to clarify and continue support for the video conferencing equipment necessary for the processing of domestic violence restraining orders at the Gateway Center for Domestic Violence Services in a form substantially in conformance with Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this agreement delay assumption of formal responsibility by the Oregon Judicial Department to care for equipment already operating in the downtown courthouse.
