

ORDINANCE No. 186215

*Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the NW Thurman Street (Balch Gulch) Bridge over Macleay Park (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Transportation received a grant the Federal Highway Bridge Program in the amount of \$3.392 Million for the rehabilitation of the historic NW Thurman Street (Balch Gulch) Bridge (25B15) in March 2013. The total project cost is estimated to be \$3.781 Million, of which \$388,309 will be local City match.
2. This rehabilitation project is identified in the City's Transportation System Plan.
3. The Bureau of Transportation has funds budgeted in FY 2013-14 through FY 2014-15 for the design, construction, inspection and management of the project.
4. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimate for this project is high, based on the defined scope and completed plans and specifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Office is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to PBOT T00391 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the Funding Agreement requires that the project be Advertised for bidding in September 2013; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
