## ORDINANCE No. $18623^2$

Amend the contract with Deborah Meihoff, Communitas LLC., to provide an additional \$20,000 to continue work on the Comprehensive Plan Facilitation. (Ordinance: amend Contract No. 30002659)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds that:

- 1. On June, 5, 2012, the City entered into a \$50,000 Professional, Technical and Expert (PTE) on-call contract with Deborah Meihoff, Communitas LLC., to perform services to assist the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability (BPS) plan, coordinate and facilitate public discussions and report on meetings and events as shown in Exhibit A.
- 2. The work provided by the Consultant directly supports the update of the Comprehensive Plan as part of its Periodic Review by the State Department of Land Conservation and Development. The Bureau of Planning and Sustainability formed eight Policy Expert Groups (PEGs) to help develop, review and provide comments to City staff on proposed policy recommendations as part of the periodic review process.
- 3. On May, 13, 2013 Amendment No. 1 of this contract added an additional \$10,000 to provide additional services as described in the Scope of Work in Exhibit B.
- 4. Additional services are required to assist the City with the continuing work of the Policy Expert Groups, ad hoc working groups, and formation and facilitation of new Advisory Committees that will assist with the Comprehensive Plan implementation projects through December 31, 2014.
- 5. The City anticipates that the consultant will need to continue to work with Advisory Committees and PEGs through December 31, 2014. Amendment No. 2 adds \$20,000, the estimated cost to complete the development of the Comprehensive Plan and Comprehensive Plan implementation projects. This brings the total contract to \$80,000, an increase of more than 25 percent for continuing services described in Exhibits A and B to this Ordinance.
- 6. Sufficient funds are available in the adopted 2013-14 Bureau of Planning and Sustainability budget, Cost Center PNCP000001. Funding for expenses July 1, 2014 December 31, 2014 will be set aside in the 2014-15 Bureau of Planning and Sustainability budget.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to amend Contract No. 30002659 with Deborah Meihoff, Communitas LLC., for an additional \$20,000 to provide services in accordance with Amendment 2 attached as Exhibit C.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the FY 2013-14 budget for Bureau of Planning and Sustainability, when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.
