## ORDINANCE No. 186238

\* Authorize application to the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for a Hazard Mitigation Grant in the amount of \$110,000 for a pilot residential seismic strengthening program (Ordinance).

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Oregon Office of Emergency Management (OEM) has identified funding that could be made available to up to 30 Oregon homeowners to reimburse them for 75% of the cost of the recommended seismic upgrades as a part of a pilot program.
- 2. While evaluating homes for energy efficiency, Clean Energy Works Oregon has also been identifying homes that could benefit from seismic upgrades.
- 3. OEM would make \$100,000 available to reimburse homeowners and \$10,000 available to Clean Energy Works Oregon for managing this project. The Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) would administer these funds locally.
- 4. This grant requires a 25% match. Local match in the amount of \$33,334 will be provided by funds from homeowners that are reimbursed for upgrades. The remaining match of \$3,334 will be made through contributed equivalent hours from existing City staff.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for a grant in the amount of \$110,000.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in that any delay in the application for this grant will result in losing the opportunity for funding these activities. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
