

ORDINANCE No. 186241

* Authorize a grant agreement for an amount not to exceed \$40,000 with SE Works Inc., a community based workforce development organization, to provide education, training, employment and supportive services. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. SE Works Inc., established in 1997, functions as a community-based workforce development organization (CBDO) focusing on education, training, employment and other supportive services to provide tools and employment opportunities for community members.
2. In 2004, SE Works was established as a Portland Public Schools (PPS) alternative school.
3. SE Works Inc. partnered with community organizations in the region to form the Portland Partners Re-Entry Initiative (PPRI), which helps transition previously incarcerated individuals back into the Portland community.
4. In 2008, SE Works joined with the Oregon Employment Department (OED) and Worksystems, Inc. (WSI) to expand services in southeast Portland and become WorkSource Portland Metro-SE (WSPM-SE).
5. Representing both local and regional employers, SE Works Inc. maintains its reputation as a valued community resource which provides unique and important services to many individuals.
6. In accordance with the City Council's Special Appropriations for FY 2013-14 Adopted Budget The City now desires to make a grant to SE Works Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$40,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Utilities is hereby authorized to execute a grant agreement for \$40,000 in one-time funds to SE Works Inc. substantially in conformance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A to the original of this Ordinance.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to Special Projects fund when demand is presented and approved by proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because any delay in providing grant funding to allow SE Works Inc. to expeditiously proceed with procuring appropriate services would harm the public interest; therefore, the ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.


