#### ORDINANCE No.

Establish employment restrictions for the Ombudsman position to further safeguard the integrity and independence of the Office of the Ombudsman (Ordinance; amend Code Section 3.77.050)

The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. There is value to both the public and City officials in having an independent and impartial office under the authority of the City Auditor that investigates complaints about City agencies.
- 2. The actual and perceived independence and impartiality of the Ombudsman is further protected by prohibiting the Ombudsman from working for any of the City agencies the Ombudsman is empowered to investigate for a period of years prior to and after serving as Ombudsman.
- 3. The proposed employment restrictions are modeled after the restrictions placed upon the National Taxpayer Advocate (Internal Revenue Service Ombudsman).

#### NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. PCC 3.77.050 Qualifications and Prohibitions is amended by adding the following new subsections:
  - C. A person may serve as the Ombudsman only if the person agrees not to accept any employment with or compensation from the City for at least 2 years after leaving the Office of the Ombudsman.
  - D. Employment by the Auditor's Office shall not be taken into account in applying Subsection C above.
- b. Subsections 3.77.050C. and D. shall apply to the incumbent Ombudsman.
