

ORDINANCE No. 186298

*Authorize a contract for CityFleet to purchase a special purpose truck for \$40,000. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The CityFleet Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Services recognizes the need for one special purpose truck to be used by the Bureau of Emergency Management to tow the current emergency communications trailer and provide additional seating to transport personnel and equipment to emergency incidents.
2. It has been determined that one special purpose truck needs to be purchased for the Bureau of Emergency Management, Exhibit A attached.
3. The estimated cost of this vehicle is \$40,000.
4. The City now desires to purchase this vehicle.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to issue a purchase order for one special purpose truck, Exhibit A, in accordance with City Code 5.33.
- b. The Commissioner and Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for said purchases from Portland Bureau of Emergency Management budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with the purchase would unnecessarily deprive the City of the use of this vehicle at an early date; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
