The Office of Neighborhood Involvement (ONI) has requested to purchase two new additions to the Fleet. Equipment Number N14003 is a Ford Transit Connect for the graffiti abatement program. This purchase price of this vehicle is estimated to cost \$26,500 and have annual operations and maintenance costs of \$2,700. The annual replacement costs are estimated at \$3,314. ONI has identified funding for this request. The second vehicle is a new hybrid sedan for the Noise Control Program, equipment number N140002. The purchase price is \$28,500 and annual operations and maintenance costs are \$1,560. The annual replacement costs are estimated to be \$2,850. Charges for replacement, fuel and repair services occur in accordance with the interagency agreement between CityFleet and ONI. The present interagency agreement for FY 2014 does not include operational costs associated with this equipment and the agreement will have to be adjusted upon receipt of the new equipment.

### 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The Office of Neighborhood Involvement is requesting the addition of one hybrid sedan for the Noise Control program and one mini cargo van for the Graffiti Abatement program to be used by two new staff members to fulfill their duties and responsibilities on a daily basis. The estimated cost of these vehicles is \$55,000.
